Press Release on the meeting between the Honourable Minister of Human Resources and Emiratisation of the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and H.E. Krishna Prasad Dhakal, Ambassador of Nepal to the UAE.

His Excellency Mr. Krishna Prasad Dhakal paid a courtesy call on Honourable Dr. Abdulrahman Abdulmannan Al Awar, the Minister of Human Resources and Emiratisation of the Government of the UAE at the latter's office today.

During the meeting, two sides exchanged views on protecting and promoting the interests of the Nepali migrant workers working in the UAE. H.E. Krishna Prasad Dhakal thanked the government of the UAE for taking care of Nepali migrant workers during these trying times of Covid-19 pandemic and providing medical equipments and supplies to Nepal to help fight against the pandemic.

Honourable Minister praised the hard work and sincerity of the Nepali migrant workers and stated that the UAE wants to be a global labour market with labour friendly standards. He informed that the new labour law, effective from February 2, 2022, contains many provisions friendly to the workers. Honourable Minister also stressed on the need to convene Joint Committee Meeting, as provisioned in the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Nepal and the UAE in the Recruitment, Employment and Repatriation of Workers, as soon as possible.

They further discussed matters related to enhancing cooperation in skill development of Nepali migrant workers including establishing a Polytechnique Institute in Nepal to cater the growing need of the skillful manpower in the UAE market, especially in the field of health care and engineering.

The meeting was attended by the high-level officials from the Ministry of Human Resources and Emiratisation and Minister Counselor and Labor Attaché from the Embassy of Nepal.
