Press Release on the Visit of the Rt. Hon. Mr. Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda' to the United Arab Emirates at the COP 28 Dubai, UAE

Rt. Hon. Prime Minister Mr. Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda', departed from Dubai, the United Arab Emirates, to Kathmandu on 3 December 2023 after attending the High-level Segment of the 28th Conference of Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP 28) held from 1-2 December 2023.

In the morning, Rt. Hon. Prime Minister delivered a statement on “Delivering Early Warnings for All” jointly organized by IMO, UNDRR, ITU, and IFRC. In the event, which was also addressed by the UN Secretary-General, Rt. Hon. Prime Minister stressed the need of ensuring resources and technology to the Least Developed Countries like Nepal to combat climate-induced disasters. Rt. Hon. thanked the UN Secretary-General for enlisting Nepal in the Early Warnings for All Initiative.

Prior to the departure, Rt. Hon. Mr. Andrew Mitchell, Minister of State for the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office of the United Kingdom, paid a courtesy call on the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister. In the meeting, matters related to bilateral and multilateral cooperation, including climate change were discussed.

Her Excellency Noura bint Mohammed Al Kaabi, Minister of State, H.E. Khaled Abdullah Belhoul, Undersecretary at Ministry of Foreign Affairs, UAE, H.E. Mr. Tej Bahadur Chhetri, Ambassador of Nepal to the UAE, H. E. Mr. Abdulla Al Shamshi, Ambassador of the UAE to Nepal and other officials from the Embassy of Nepal and Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the UAE bade farewell to the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister at the airport.
